In Regards to an Emergency ASUCR Senate Meeting to Be Held on May 1, 2015

Argued May 1, 2015 - Decided May 1, 2015

The Judicial Council has made the final ruling that the proposed Emergency Senate Meeting on 5/1/2015 (Friday, May 1st) at 7:00 AM requested by President Pro-Tempore, Devin Plazo, is unconstitutional due to the failure to provide proper public notice forty-eight (48) hours before any official meetings may be held. No public notice for the proposed Senate Meeting was provided on or before Wednesday 7:00 AM, 4/29/2015. Therefore, no Official ASUCR Senate Meeting can take place on the proposed date and time. If individual members of ASUCR do meet at the requested time, it will not be an ASUCR Senate Meeting, nor will any members of ASUCR have the capacity to make any official motions. The following is shortened excerpt from the ASUCR Constitution:

ARTICLE V: Legislative Branch

SECTION G. Meetings

2. Notice of Meeting

(a) A forty-eight (48) hour public notice must be given before an official meeting may be held;
