**BACKGROUND**

The general amendments to Chapter VIII are to be consistent with the recent change on Voter Director and added Chief Justice due to annual budget change from previous Senate session. The remaining amendments are removing abbreviations for clarity.

**THE ASUCR SENATE HEREBY AMENDS CHAPTER VIII OF THE ASUCR BYLAWS AS FOLLOWS,**

1. **Section 6, Subsection C.**

2. **Section 7, Subsection C.** Once the proposal has been approved by the LRC, it is sent to the Finance Committee. ~~The Finance Committee reviews the prior and proposed budget. A two thirds (2/3) majority vote of the committee and the signature of the Vice President of Finance;~~ is required for approval;
3. **Section 10.** Withholding Stipends – The ASUCR President and Executive Vice President have authority to withhold stipends for Officers or Senators who have not fulfilled their duties. ~~Stipend withholding disputes may be reviewed by the Judicial Branch (JB) as outlined in the Judicial Code-~~
  - b. The Chief Justice ~~of the JB~~ shall call a meeting to bear and judge the case according to the Judicial Branch Code. The Chief Justice shall also inform the Senate, in closed session or confidential writing that such a hearing will take place;
