



Pace

The Financial Aid Office will measure pace at the end of the spring quarter each year. Pace is calculated by dividing the cumulative units completed by the cumulative units attempted.

EXAMPLE

92.00 completed units divided by 119.00 attempted units = 77% pace.

Undergraduate Pace

To meet satisfactory academic progress, students must complete at least 67% of the cumulative units attempted.

- a. The completed transfer units accepted by UCR count in the pace calculation.
- b. Units for the following grades are; 1) **not** counted as **completed** units, but 2) are counted as attempted units.
 - F - Failure
 - I - Incomplete
 - NR - No Report
 - NC - No Credit
 - IP - In Progress
 - W - Withdrawal
- c. AP and IB credits are not used in the calculation of pace.
- d. Repeated courses will count as completed if the student receives credit for the course.
- e. Remedial courses are counted in the units attempted and the number of units completed if the course is recognized by the Registrar's Office in measuring a student's enrollment status.

Graduate Pace

Graduate students must successfully complete (grades F, I, NR, NC, IP, and W are excluded) 75% of the cumulative graduate units attempted to meet satisfactory academic progress.

- a. Repeated courses will count in the cumulative units if the student received credit for the course.
- b. Remedial courses are counted in the cumulative units if they are recognized by the Registrar's Office in measuring a student's enrollment status.
